
## House of Yoder News (September 2007)



House of Yoder Envisions the Future-The House of Yoder board met in a special session on March 31, 2007 to do visioning work for the future of House of Yoder. We noted the following accomplishments over the past 15 years: the successful completion of a colonial-style house with architectural integrity without incurring ongoing debt; the building of meaningful relationships with both Yoder and non-Yoders thereby inspiring others to explore and appreciate their family and faith heritage; successfully hosting a National Yoder Reunion in October 2006; and using the house in a variety of other ways (e.g. Grantsville Summerfest, Christmas in the Village, reunions, showers, house church services, and Christmas parties).

The board also brainstormed many ideas for the future. The following strategic needs were identified: 1) clarifying our mission, 2) broadening and developing our financial base, 3) developing a marketing strategy, and 4) working at board development. In our August 25 board meeting, the theme of board development was highlighted as one of our priorities. This will entail both the development of the current board and the recruitment of new members for the board.
